- 1. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: None
- 2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: On a motion by P Stewart and a second by M Naito, the minutes of the regular meeting of February 19, 2024 were unanimously approved as emailed.
- 3. POTENTIAL CONFLICTS OF INTEREST: No potential conflicts were identified.
- 4. GSA/GSP (SGMA): Garth reported the spring 2024 well measurements are 7'-14' above the 2015 depth to water levels. The draft annual update report is complete except for 2023 water supply which Don will provide to Garth. Spring well measurements from Madera Pumps attached.

Garth advised the Water Smart Grant application is due May 21<sup>st</sup> with a 25% local funding match. Don advised the District needs to install Rubicon Gates at the first 5 weirs in CWC starting at Rd 20 to south of Ave 7. Board concurred. Garth to proceed with application.

Garth also provided a contract proposal for the 5-year GSP update with a cost of \$140,000 + amount. This will be a discussion/action item for the April agenda.

- 7. MADERA REGIONAL WATER MANAGEMENT GROUP: Highlights of February meeting:
  - Updated status of various activities; Same as January, meter installations at Indian Lakes, Parksdale, Parkwood and City of Madera
  - Still awaiting a response of the ByLaws
  - Still working on obtaining some entity to take over RWMG Accounting Functions.

- 8. PROP "218": Garth provided a cost sheet recommendation to the Board with a recommended first year rate of \$41.18 acre assessment for funding as follows:
  - \$150,000 for Operations and Maintenance Costs
  - \$ 48,000 for Capital Costs
  - \$ 10,500 for a 3% Contingency

There would be a maximum upper limit of \$60 per acre.

The proposed schedule would be to review and approve proceeding with a Prop "218" election at the April 15<sup>th</sup> Board meeting and set the 45 day public review period. Send out ballots and count votes at the June 17<sup>th</sup> meeting. If there is a favorable vote, then provide the required information to the Madera County Assessor's Office by August 1, 2024.

Annual report, we have the draft report, which still needs the well measurements and water balance to complete and then we can file with the DWR on the SGMA portal. The annual report is an accounting of what has been completed during the last water year and the measurements of the groundwater levels.

We have provided a draft cost proposal for the Five-year update or Periodic Evaluation for the GSA to bring the GSP current from the accepted revised GSP we completed last year. We have been working on a T&M basis through all the annual reports and revision, we will continue on the same approach, just wanted you to know the magnitude of the effort for the required report.

WaterSMART Grant – the application is due May 21<sup>st</sup>, there is a 25% match for the funding, so if we want to pursue this funding we would need approval to move ahead to meet the deadline.

We need to determine the rate per acre for the assessment, based on discussion from last month's meeting we put it at the \$41.18 per acre, but there was talk about having an upper limit of \$60.00 per acre and cancelling the current assessment that has a \$30.00 per acre upper limit. We just need to know so we can show what the upper number is to the public in the report.
