- (c) Garth reviewed his attached January 17th Report.
- (d) The Department of Water Resources is requiring that the Madera Subbasin submit a single Annual Report and a Joint GSP Annual Report. Davids Engineering, the Point of Contact between the Madera Subbasin and the State DWR has a proposed cost sharing for the tasks involved. The GFWD GSA share will be \$7,407.14 for the extra costs to the P.O.C. Upon a motion by D Kirk and a second by P Stewart, the Board of the GFWD GSA voted unanimously to agree to the attached cost sharing proposal.
- 6. INTERCONNECTED SURFACE WATER MOU: Don and Garth reviewed the MOU and provided the Board with the issues and questions that were sent to our P.O.C. along with the responses received. The Board felt that there were too many unresolved issues still pending and that the scope of the MOU exceeded the the stipulations and far exceeded the main issue of "sharing of data". The GFWD GSA is more than willing to share and discuss data issues. The Board stated they could not commit the GSA or its landowners to the what if's of the MOU and that items that arise should be dealt with after there is more information and knowledge available for now hypothetical issues.

On a motion by P Stewart and a second by M Naito, the Board voted unanimously to adopt Resolution No. 2025-04 which gave the General Manager, Don Roberts, the approval to sign the Interconnected Surface Water MOU with the stipulation that the GFWD GSA only agrees the "sharing of data" portions of the subject MOU by the following vote:

8. ANNEXATION REQUESTS: Don reported it was his understanding that the landowners within the current Sphere of Influence will be meeting to come up with a proposal that would be beneficial to both the District landowners and the proposed annexors. If we are able to arrive at a conclusion for those lands, then the District can evaluate the other current requests and possible future requests with an adopted criteria for inclusion.

- 9. FINANCIAL REPORT: The Board was presented with a summary of the January 20, 2025 bills, the January 20, 2025 summary of the District's Temporary Investments and the December 2025 Income & Expenses for the year, along with the monthly totals of Temporary Investments for 2023, 2024 and 2025. On a motion by D Kirk and a second by M Naito, the Board voted unanimously to approve payment of the November bills in the amount of \$32,022.02.
- 10. CORRESPONDENCE & MANAGER'S REPORT:
  - (a) District received an inquiry from a landowner representative about the GSA's interest to explore potential partnerships for recharge projects. The Board directed Don to followup on this item.
  - (b) Don reported the GSA received a Well Verification Form from Madera County Environmental Health for a proposed new well by a landowner in GF. The location in question is bordered on all sides by additional property of this landowner. There are no issues with this request and the GSA has so advised the County.
  - (c) The Board was advised of a request to the Madera County Board of Supervisors to approve the formation of Bonita Water District in the Madera Subbasin.
